

**Minutes of the District Level Vigilance & Monitoring Committee Meeting of Khowai District held on 9<sup>th</sup> January, 2013 at 11.A.M in the conference hall of D.M's Office Khowai.**

The list of names of Public Representatives and Officers present in the meeting is given at Annexure-A.

The meeting was chaired by Shri Sachindra Deb Barma, Hon'ble MLA as per consent of the house during the meeting as Smt. Jharna Das (Baidya), Hon'ble MP, Rajya Sabha, was absent in the meeting.

Smt. Tanusree Deb Barma, D.M & Collector, Khowai District, initiated the discussion by welcoming all the participants present in the meeting. Thereafter, she made a power point presentation highlighting the achievements of different Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Khowai District .

The following Schemes were discussed in the meeting:

**1. MGNREGA**

The D.M & Collector, Khowai District, informed the house that, as on date the total available fund under Central & State share was ₹. 10019.42 lakhs under MGNREGA. The expenditure incurred by the District is 5529.50 lakhs till date and the percentage of expenditure against the available fund is 55.18%. The average Mandays generated/achieved up to the month of December, 2012 is 52 only and the total number of families who have completed 100 days is 1849 only. The D.M & Collector, Khowai District assured the house that, by mid January, 2013, 60% of the available fund under MGNREGA would be spent and proposal for release of 3<sup>rd</sup> instalment of funds under MGNREGA shall be submitted to the R.D. Department, Government of Tripura.

The D.M & Collector, Khowai District also highlighted that the completion rate of works in Kalyanpur, Khowai and Tulasikhar R.D Block is not satisfactory. However, she assured the house that necessary steps will be taken to increase it significantly. She also informed the house that the percentage of participation of SC, ST, women in MGNREGA work in the District is very good.

**2. IAY:**

The D.M & Collector, Khowai District, informed the house that, as on date the total available of fund under IAY (normal) Central & State share was ₹. 367.134 lakhs only, out of which an amount of ₹. 357.26 lakhs only was expended up to the month of December, 2012. The fund

for material portion have been placed to the R.D Department and GCI sheet against entire target will be supplied from R.D store to all Blocks.

Further, funds have already been placed to the respective BDOs as per the allocation of target. The fund will be released by the concerned BDOs to the beneficiaries in their individual accounts in 3(three) instalments as per the progress of works.

The D.M & Collector, Khowai District, informed the house that, out of the target of 1176 nos. normal IAY house of previous year 2011-12, 1174 have already been completed and out of 1514 nos. normal IAY house of this year target, only 21 nos. is completed. However, she assured the house that, the entire target will be completed by the end of this financial year.

Under RoFR (IAY) for the previous year, total 2410 nos. was received by the District and out of which, 2408 nos. houses are already completed. The remaining houses will be completed by the end of March, 2013. During this year, under the said scheme, 706 nos. houses were sanctioned and the work is in-progress.

**3. Rastriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY):**

The Dy. Director, Agriculture informed the house that under RKVY, 5 components were implemented by the Agriculture Department. These 5 components are:-

- i) Popularising of paddy cultivation through System of Rice intensification (SRI):- Under this scheme total 125.46 lakhs fund was received during this year and out of which, 121.98 lakhs is already incurred expenditure. The physical target was 9320 hectare and till date 5321 hectare have been achieved by the department up to the month of December, 2012. The balance 208 hectare will be taken up in next season.
- ii) Assistance for critical inputs for Aush paddy in non SRI areas (JCM): The target under the scheme have been kept at 991 hectares. The total fund received against the scheme is ₹. 13.44 lakh. However, since the Department have received the fund late in the month of September, 2012, the scheme could not be implemented. The Scheme will be implemented in the month of April- May'2013.
- iii) Assistance for Agriculture crop production in FRA areas: The target under this scheme was 854 hectare. The total fund received against the scheme is ₹. 6.49 lakh. The entire target has been achieved by the Department.
- iv) Assistance for Hybrid paddy cultivation: The target under this scheme was 1493 hectare. The total fund received against the scheme is ₹. 10.09 lakh. The entire fund



has been expended by the Department and also the entire target of 1493 has been achieved.

- v) Maximizing productivity of Jhum Cropping System: The target under this scheme was kept 1400 hectare. The total out lay against the scheme is ₹. 47.32 lakh. However, no fund has been received by the Department till date.

Further, Dy. Director, Agriculture informed the house that, apart from this there are other components under RKVY which is being implemented by the ARDD and Fishery Department which need to be reviewed in the next meeting in order to know the latest status. In the next VMC meeting, the concerned Departments should be invited and it should be included in the agenda points of the meeting.

**4. Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP):**

The Dy. Projects Officer informed the house that, as many as 9 micro projects are being implemented under this scheme in Khowai District. He also informed that, IWMP is mainly related to soil conservation works in the identified watershed projects. Under this scheme works like construction of water harvesting structure, livestock activities, plantations, assistance to self help group, capacity building etc. are being taken up. So, far ₹. 408.25799 lakhs have been received and out of which ₹. 219.55 lakhs have been expended. The percentage of expenditure is almost 54%. The balance fund will be expended within the month of March'2013. The total no. of beneficiaries benefited under this scheme is 889 nos.

Sri Sachindra Deb Barma, Hon'ble MLA, pointed out that officials of Agriculture Department are not taking the PRI bodies (Block level watershed committee) into confidence in implementing the IWMP scheme in Purbarajnar and Samrucherra under Tulasikhar Block. The Dy. Projects Officer need to redress the problem by making joint visit with PRI Bodies in Tulasikhar Block at the earliest.

**5. Prime Minister Gramin Sarak Yozana (PMGSY):**

The entire picture of PMGSY scheme of Khowai District is not highlighted to the Members present in the meeting due to the absence of SE, PMGSY (PWD). However, EE, Khowai Division had attempted to brief the house about the latest progress of PMGSY scheme under his jurisdiction. He informed that, under Khowai Block out of 20 new connectivity 16 have been completed and remaining will be completed within very short period. Similarly, in Padmabil Block out of 16 new connectivity 15 have been completed and remaining will be



completed within very short period. Further, in Tulasikhar Block out of 22 new connectivity 19 have been completed and remaining will be completed within very short period.

However, Shri Manindra Das, Hon'ble MLA kalyanpur and Sri. Sachindra Deb Barma, Hon'ble MLA pointed out that, most of the completed roads are damaged and required maintenance work immediately. D.M & Collector, Khowai District instructed EE, PWD, Khowai Divn. to prepare a comprehensive list of roads where repair and maintenance work is essential. A letter shall be written to SE, PWD to seek clarification as to why no representation attended in the meeting.

**6. Accelerated Rural Water Supply Programme (ARWSP):**

The EE, DWS informed the house that, Accelerated Rural Water Supply Programme (ARWSP) have been renamed as National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP). He also informed the house that, the availability of fund is ₹. 447.81 lakhs, out of which ₹. 446.13 lakh was expended and the percentage of expenditure is 99.62%. Further, he also informed that, in the year 1998, the entire habitations of Tripura have been declared as Fully Covered Habitation/Para by the State Government. However, thereafter, 112 habitations have slipped back to NC Habitation from Fully Covered Habitation in subsequent years. He informed that, out of these 112 habitations, he has converted 41 as partially covered Para. A part from this, sinking of Deep Tube Wells against target of 20, 5 have been achieved and against target of commissioning of 20, 15 have been achieved. Installation of Iron removal Plant target was 13 of which 3 have been achieved and target of extension of Pipe Line of 136 km., 101 km has been achieved.

**7. Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC):**

The EE, DWS informed that, total available fund is ₹. 229.18 lakh, out of which ₹. 107.90 lakh have been expended. The percentage of expenditure is 47.08 up to the month of Meeting. He also briefed the house about the achievement of TSC scheme. He informed that, 13635 nos. IHHL have been constructed against APL and 46542 nos. IHHL have been constructed against BPL families. Besides, 274 nos. School Latrine, 214 nos. Anganwadi Latrine and 2 nos. Community Sanitary Latrine have been constructed during the year.

**8. SGSY:**

The ADM-cum-PD, Khowai District reported that, the District Rural Development Agency, Khowai has become functional since 01.04.2012. The latest status reports of SGSY/SHG was



highlighted by PD, Khowai District in the meeting. The target and achievement of DRDA, Khowai for the Financial Year 2012-13 is given as below:

₹. 17.88 lakhs was provided against 184 nos. SHGs under Revolving Fund during the year. The District has sponsored 193 Nos. of SHG for SGSY loan to various Bank Branches out of which 185 Nos. of cases have been sanctioned and disbursed which involved ₹. 546.964 Lakh. The overall performances of SGSY is satisfactory. There are 47 Nos. of sanctioned posts and out of which 39 nos. of post are still vacant. The manpower shortages needs to be solved once the election process is over.

**9. National Land records Modernisation Programme (NLRMP):**

Officer-in-charge, Revenue Section, D.M office Khowai informed the house that, total ₹. 21.64 lakh fund have been received and out of which ₹. 9.29 lakhs have been expended for Modernizing of Land Records, strengthening of existing infrastructure in Tehsil/D.C offices and upgrading Jami soft under Khowai district.

**10. National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP):**

Due to the absence of DISE the scheme could not be reviewed in the meeting. A letter seeking clarification for such absence shall be sought immediately.
