

Tour Note of Ms. Tanusree Deb Barma, IAS, District Magistrate & Collector, Khowai

Administrative –cum- Health camp and VHND held at Ujjan Maidan under East Champacherra ADC Villages under Tulashikar RD Block on 21.07.2012.

The undersigned visited Ujjan Maidan habitation under East Champachera ADC Village during Health-cum-Administration camp organized by SDM, Khowai. A VHND was also held. As per the 100% Immunization initiative of the district, the house to house survey and immunization day was also conducted.

There are 99 household in the habitation of which 77 own REGA Job Cards. As per ROR the population of the habitation is 500. The habitation is located on Atharamura Range and in the absence of any road connectivity, the walking distance/time is about 6 K.M. and 2 hours. There are 2 Angan Wadi Centers (AWC) in the habitation namely Rabia Smriti and Ujjan Maidan AWC. There is one Junior Basic School in the habitation. There are 69 Forest Patta holders. The issues discussed with the people during the Camp are as follows:-

(1) Pre-School education:

- a) Rabia Smriti AWC has no building. Work order was cancelled due to fund paucity. From the current fund released by the Planning & Co-ordination department that have given for the purpose of completing all AWCs, this AWC should be immediately completed as per the GCI sheets model.

Action by BDO, Tulashikar

- b) It was informed that Angan Wadi Worker (AWW) of Ujjan Maidan AWC was married and she shifted to Sipaihour Village of Khowai Block. CDPO, Tulashikar shall have to take immediate action for posting of new AWW in the locality.

Action by CDPO, Tulashikar

- c) AWW of Rabia Smriti AWC was earlier the ASHA of the locality and after she was given the job of AWW, no alternative ASHA has been selected. MO I/C, Tulashikar PHC and CMO, Khowai may take immediate action for appointment of new ASHA or explore the possibility of continuation of AWW as ASHA for the locality till replacement is found.

Action by CMO, Khowai/ MO, I/C, Tulashikar PHC.

(2) Health:

- a) The Immunization position was reviewed. It was found that many of the mothers were not aware of the immunizations that are compulsory between the ages of 0 – 1 year. Elaborate discussions were made under the ambit of VHND. MPW and MPS also conducted the house to house survey for children between the age of 0 – 1 and pregnant mothers. All the mothers present in the VHND took an oath that they would ensure full immunization of their own children as well as other children of the locality. Now the following action are require by the line departments:-

Action by CMO/BDO/CDPO

(3) School Education:

There is only one Junior Basic School here and the nearest Senior Basic School is located at Bhatimaidan Senior Basic School which is 6 K.M. away. It is unfair to assume that the children will attend school so far away. The Villagers were very vocal about the teacher absenteeism. The teachers also expressed that student attendance is very poor. The following steps are immediately required:-

- a) There are 6 -7 children who do not continue schooling after passing class 5 last year. Inspector of Schools, Tulashikar(ADC) shall take immediate action to ensure that willing students are admitted into Bharat Sardar HS School where Hostel facility is available.
- b) A separate direction should be given by **DEO, Khowai** to the 3 teachers of Ujjan Maidan JB School warning them and ensuring that they attend school daily. The baseline survey for learning levels was conducted in this school and they were asked to ensure that basis minimum learning levels shall have to ensure for all 22 school students. The 3 teachers were told that if there is substantial improvement in learning levels of the students, they shall be considered for relief posting with 13-14.

(4) Drinking Water:

There are no underground sources in the habitation. The only solution to the woes of this habitation is use of surface water. **EE, DWS shall submit report** immediately with respect to storing the mountain stream water and its purification.

Action by EE, DWS, Kalyanpur/SDO, DWS, Tulashikar

(5) Employment Generation:

Though the block achieved average 100 mandays for 11-12 the people of the village were not aware of how many days they had worked for. Some also complained that they had not received payment for their last works done. BDO shall put up the bank account details of all 79 job cards and show me scrolls sent to the bank regarding payments made. Dinamala Deb Barma w/o Lt. Khirod D/B had not been able to withdraw money after her husband's death as the BC was only recognizing her husband's fingerprint. BDO shall ensure that she can withdraw the amount immediately.

Action by BDO, Tulashikar

(6) Forest Patta Holders:

7 more forest land occupants need to be issued pattas. Their application may be pending at SDM office of ADC Village office. SDM shall take necessary action immediately.

I visited some of the mango plantations taken up last year under mgnrega. A total of 8 beneficiaries were picked last year. At this pace all beneficiaries would not be able to be covered in the come 3 years. BDO to ensure 1/3 of the balance beneficiaries are covered under IGA activities this year rather than giving double benefits to those who have already received some or the other benefit.

OC TW to follow up the matter.

(7) Electricity:

People demanded that solar lamps may be given to them so that their children can study education. Matter shall be taken up with the TW Dept. by O/C GI.

Action by OC, General Section.

(8) Sanitation:

Open defecation is being is being practiced. BDO was requested to ensure that the squatting plates (plastic) are immediately given to the habitation. 5-6 units are constructed in the houses of willing households (it seemed many very interested) immediately and report by the 31st July. He shall ensure coverage of the whole habitation within Sept 2012. The school toilet shall also have to be completed through GCI sheet model on priority. MS, DWSC shall follow up the issue with BDO.

Action by Member Secretary DWSC/BDO, Tulashikar

(9) Road Connectivity:

Rs.50 lakhs has been sanctioned under BADP this year. Rs. 1 Crore was also asked for under ACA/SPA. PWD had prepared an estimate of 4 Crores of which 3 crores was only for earth cutting works. EE, RD has already started the works but I was not sure if the estimate had been recast as per RD schedule. OC, BADP shall take action immediately. We shall also have to pursue with the RD and PWD dept regarding bringing this and some other habitations sanctioned under special projects under MORD especially as this can be classified as a 500+ habitation.
