

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE DISTRICT LEVEL VIGILANCE & MONITORING COMMITTEE, KHOWAI DISTRICT HELD ON 22.06.2016 AT 11.00 AM IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF DM'S OFFICE, KHOWAI.

Date and Time of the meeting: 22nd June, 2016 at 11.00 AM.

Venue: Conference Hall of the Khowai District Magistrate Office, Khowai.

A meeting of the District Vigilance & Monitoring Committee, Khowai was held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jitendra Chaudhury, Hon'ble MP (LS) on 22nd June, 2016 to take stock of the status of implementation of various Schemes and programs with special reference to MGNREGS, IAY, PMAY, SBM, MPLADS, NHM, NRLM, PMGSY, IWMP, NSAP etc in the District. Participants of the meeting included Smt Saini Sarkar, Hon'ble Sabhadhipati; Khowai Zilla Parishad & Chairpersons of the Panchayat Samittees & Block Advisory Committees of Khowai District & MLAs having the jurisdiction of Khowai District. Besides, the ADM & Collector, Khawai & all the BDOs & Officers of the concerned Line Departments have also attended the meeting.

At the beginning, the DM & Collector, Khawai welcomed the Hon'ble MP and other dignitaries and officers present in the meeting and then proceeded to present a brief account of the status of implementation of various Rural Development Schemes in the District through a power-point presentation. It was followed by one other power-point presentation on status of Health and related programmes in the District.

During the course of the meeting, Hon'ble MP (LS) made several important observations and issued certain directives to streamline and increase efficiency of implementation processes, widening the scope of development interventions, and ensuring better monitoring and vigilance of development schemes and projects. Following are the directives taken and directives issued during the course of the meeting:-

A. ISSUE RELETED TO MGNREGA IMPLEMENTATION:

1. The Physical target and achievement of the District during the last FY 2015-16 was as under:

1. The Hon'ble, MP directed all the BDOs & Line Department officials not to wait for the end of the financial year for taking up of material component works. BDOs and other line departments should take up material component works from the beginning of the financial year in proportion to permissible ratio so that problems like shortage of materials, delay in estimates preparation, lack of suitable sites etc. do not arise in taking up the materials works at the fag end of the financial year.
(Action by: **All BDOs & Line Deptts.**)
 2. The Hon'ble MP also suggested all the BDOs, Line Department officials & EE, RD Division, Teliamura to finalise the shelf of projects and get the TS estimates done well in advance from the EE, RD Division. Month-wise priority-wise shelf of projects should be sent to the RD Division for next 3 (three) months for availability of TS estimates as early as possible.
(Action by: **All BDOs & Line Deptts.**)
 3. The Completion of works should be expedited by all the BDOs and other PIAs of the District and to ensure that completed works are recorded in the asset register of GPs/VCs.
(Action by: **All BDOs & Line Deptts.**)
 4. It has been reported that linking of Aadhaar with bank accounts of the MGNREGA workers will be completed by 30th July 2016. The Hon'ble MP also suggested linking of the MPJDY accounts with the Aadhaar numbers.
(Action by: **All BDOs & Line Deptts.**)
 5. The Hon'ble MP cautioned all the BDOs and PIAs to be very careful in procurement of planting materials. They are advised to follow the due procedures of financial rule for any sort of procurement under the Scheme.
(Action by: **All BDOs & Line Deptts.**)
- B. ISSUES RELATED TO IMPLANTATION FOR RURAL HOUSING:**
- The DM & Collector, Khowai reported that the targeted construction of houses under the IAY (Normal) sanctioned for the year 2014-15 are completed physically and MIS has also been completed in due time. Similarly, the targeted allocations of IAY (Normal) for the FY 2015-16 are nearing completion.

Inspections for release of 3rd instalment funds are going on in all the blocks of the District. All the houses are expected to be completed within the time frame. He had also reported the block-wise five year plan for covering all the eligible households including Tong Ghar with IAY housing.

Further, he had reported the status of newly launched Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY-G) as per SECC data 2011 in Khowai District. The Hon'ble MP had instructed the BDOs and Chairpersons of various PS & BAC to closely monitor the implementation through door to door visit of the concerned beneficiaries and ensure cent percent completion within the prescribed time.

C. SWAACH BHARAT MISSION (SBM):

The DM & Collector appraised the present status of construction of the targeted individual Household Latrines (IHHLs) in 62 identified Open Defecation Free (ODF) villages, Community Sanitary Complexes (CSCs) & under SBM (G) and target of SBK for defunct toilets in the District. All the pending IHHLs shall be completed by 31st October, 2016 positively subject to availability of bricks. The Hon'ble MP advised to lay more emphasis on awareness generation campaigns and ensure that here is no any house hold left out without IHHL. He also emphasized to ensure availability of water without which such toilet units will be rendered useless.

D. ISSUES RELATED TO PMGSY:

The SE, PMGSY, Agartala presented an overview of the status of PMGSY road construction in the district. The Hon'ble MP directed that all the habitations should be connected with black topping road within the parameter of PMGSY guidelines clubbing all categories of habitations. The PWD (R&B) was asked to prepare a detailed and specific report which should contain updated status of completion of various works under PMGSY taken up in the district, details of ongoing works, committed liabilities, amount of total anticipated bills, amount already paid and pending amount including ongoing and completed works and. It was observed that PMGSY was not upto the mark and maintenance work of PMGSY Roads was done only in Khowai areas. It was advised to carry out maintenance works in all required PMGSY Roads. Proposals for 4 PMGSY Roads have to be routed through the Hon'ble MP through the DM & Collector, Khowai to take up the matter with the Ministry.

The PWD (R&B) and HSCL Ltd were found absent and nothing could be discussed in details. The Hon'ble MP instructed the District Magistrate and Collector, Khowai to invite them in the next meeting.

(Action by: **SE, PMGSY, Agartala/PWD (R&B) & HSCL**)

E. ISSUE RELATED TO NRDWP:

The PWD (DWS) Khowai reported the habitation wise status of drinking water availability in the District. The Hon'ble MP directed the PWD (DWS) Department to prepare a consolidated plan for the District. The Engineers of DWS Department were advised to move to inferior areas like

Mungiakami & Tulashikhar and see the feasibility of providing water sources both in innovative and traditional methods. He advised that immediate priority for the department should be to ensure at least quantitative availability of drinking water in every habitation of the district, with parallel actions being taken to attain qualitative coverage. The PW (DWS) Department was advised to create Innovative Projects for Drinking Water Sources at 47 Miles, 45 Miles and Bilaham para under Mungiakami.

F. ISSUE RELATED TO SOCIAL WELFARE AND SOCIAL EDUCATION:

a) NATIONAL SOCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMME:

The DISE, Khowai presented the status of implementation of NSAP like, IGNOAP, IGNDP, and IGNWP under the ICDS Department in the District. He had informed that there has been dearth of fund and no new fund was placed since April, 2016. Hence, no new beneficiaries are able to enrol under the NSAP scheme. There are number of applications received under NFBS but sanction could not be given to all due to fund constraint. The Hon'ble MP also instructed the DISE, Khowai to ensure that payment of pensions by banks are made regularly without any hassle. Beneficiaries should be allowed to draw their pensions on any working day of the week. There should not have any specific date earmarked for pensioners. Bankers should also be requested to cooperate with the pensioners since they are the most vulnerable section of the society.

(Action by: **DISE, Khowai**)

G. ISSUES RELATED TO HEALTH:

The CMO, Khowai reported the activities of Health Department in the District. In his report he had mentioned the achievement of Health Department in the district in respect of maternal health, child health, live birth & still birth, post-natal care, JSY, JSSK, Mayer Ghar, VHND & VHSNC, ASHA Incentive, RKS, Mobile Medical Unit, Mission Indradhanush, IPPI, Construction of various infrastructures, Recruitment status, vacant posts, malaria control programme, RNTCP, District Blindness control Programme, financial position etc. The CMO, Khowai also reported that during the last dry spell and onset of monsoon there was no epidemic of malaria, water borne diseases, malnutrition in the District. There are few cases of malaria and other water borne diseases in Mungiakami areas. This year no persons lost their lives due to malaria.

- a) The Hon'ble MP instructed the CMO, Khowai to conduct regular health camps and awareness campaign throughout the district. In order to prevent the death due to malaria early diagnosis and complete treatment should be ensured. Unlimited supply of logistics to the periphery health sub-centres should be ensured. Re-Tender is required to be floated again for Quarter at Ampura PHC.
- b) There was no power connection included in the original estimate of the construction of Sub-Divisional Hospital, Teliamura. The HSCL Ltd was

- requested to include it in the estimate and to arrange power connection to the Sub-Divisional Hospital, Teliamura.
- c) Date for inauguration of the Sub-Divisional Hospital, Teliamura has to be finalized.
 - d) Training facility for still birth has to be established in the District Hospital.
 - e) Malaria Test kits have to be supplied for testing of malaria Pv or Pf
 - f) It was also advised all the health functionaries in the district to keep note of available stocks of medicines and conduct DDT spray.

Misc:

- a) The PWD (R&B), HSCL & AGM, TSECL were found absent and no discussions relating to these Departments could be done. DM & Collector, Khowai was instructed to invite them in the next meeting of DLVMC meeting.
- b) The SHGs formed under the guidance of IWMP Khowai have to be utilized and linked with NERLP

The meeting ended with thanks from the chair.
